Excellence in Research Student Award 2015 - Publications

Overview

To promote and reward the significant contributions that ARC Centre of Excellence in Cognition and its Disorders (CCD) students make each year in their research fields, up to five (5) CCD Excellence in Research Student Awards (\$1,000 each) are offered for outstanding student publications.

Eligibility/Criteria

Research Students

Students need to meet the following criteria for their application to be accepted:

- The student must be an approved CCD student in 2015, and have been supervised by a CCD Chief Investigator, Partner Investigator or Associate Investigator
- The student must be the first author on the publication
- The paper must be published or in press in the 2015 calendar year, and have been provided for inclusion in the 2015 CCD Annual Report
- The publication must report research in the field of cognitive science
- The ARC Centre of Excellence in Cognition and its Disorders must be acknowledged in the author affiliation or byline in the publication.
- Students are only eligible for a single application each year
- A paper may only be submitted once

Application Process

Research Students, Program Leader & CCD HR/HDR Administrator

The student should contact their relevant Program Leader, who must endorse the publication application by signing the application form before submission. The student should forward a completed application form by 5pm AEDST 24 March 2016, including the approval from the relevant Program Leader, along with a PDF of the publication they wish considered for these awards to the CCD HR/HDR Administrator, lesley.mcknight@mq.edu.au.

The CCD Research Management Committee will assess publications on the basis of the quality of the research and the prestige of the publication.

Students can use the funds to publish in open access journals, or to provide additional travel support during their candidature, or to fund project costs related to their CCD research. Students no longer with the CCD at the time of award will receive a Co-op book voucher.

To promote the research findings of our students within the CCD research community, successful students will be required to give a presentation on their findings during the Annual Workshop (or at a locally organised CCD Seminar/Workshop).

Students will be advised of the outcome by 28 April 2016.
